

REGISTRATION

Junior registration commences in December and close at the end of February. All registrations including details on how to register can be found online via our website www.redcliffedolphins.com.au. Payments must be made at the time of registration.

Fees

The registration fee is non-refundable and includes all game day, referees, ground and affiliation fees, levies and QRL players insurance. This fee also includes playing jersey, polo shirt, yearbook, trophy and team photo.

Fair Play Vouchers

The Club accepts Fair Play Vouchers issued at the beginning of the year. If successful in obtaining a Fair Play Voucher, the voucher must be printed, signed, and emailed to football.admin@redcliffeleagues.com.au

Uniforms

Players are issued with a polo shirt and jersey which is included in the registration fees. Playing shorts and socks are compulsory and must be purchased through the Club. Items such as training kit and caps can be purchased through the Club as an optional addition.

TRAINING AND GAMES

Training

Coaches will set their team's training days and times and published them on Team App. The U6-9 will train once per week and U10 and up will train up to two times per week.

Cancellation of training due to wet weather will be advised via the Redcliffe Dolphins Facebook Junior Dolphins Group and Team App by 3pm weekdays. Our Club expects that both Junior and Senior players to attend all training sessions and follow the directions of the coach. If a player cannot attend training, please advise the coach, or team manager in advance. Trainings will be held on the fields located within Dick Tosser Turner Complex.

Games

Games are generally played on a Sunday, March- August with the finals series for competition age groups finished by mid-September. The Junior Draw is updated on the Club's website on Thursday afternoons and is subject to change. You can also download the My League App to view fixtures, results and ladders. A list of ground locations can be found via our website under the Junior Football menu. Games will be held on the fields located within Dick Tosser Turner Complex.



PLAYER AND SPECTATOR BEHAVIOUR

Player Behaviour

The Club expects all players to comply with the NRL Code of Conduct- Player. The full document can be accessed on www.playnrl.com

In summary, the Code requires all players to:

- Be a good sport and respect all good play whether from your team or the opposition.
- Shake hands with, and thank, the opposition players and officials after the game win, lose or draw.
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit.
- Always respect the Referee's decision.
- Never become involved in acts of foul play.
- Honour both the spirit and letter of the competition rules and live up to the highest ideals of ethics and sportsmanship; avoid gamesmanship and respect the traditions of the game.
- Never engage in disrespectful conduct of any sort including profanity, sledging, obscene gestures, offensive remarks, trashtalking, taunting, or other actions that are demeaning to other players, officials or supporters.
- Care for and respect the facilities and equipment made available to you during training and competition.
- Safeguard your health; do not use any illegal or unhealthy substances.
- Recognise that many Officials, Coaches and Referees are Volunteers who give up their time to provide their services Treat them with the utmost respect.

*Penalties may apply for breaches of the NRL Code of Conduct- Player.

Parent/Spectator Etiquette

The Club expects all spectators to comply with the NRL Code of Conduct- Parent/Spectator. The full document can be accessed on www.playnrl.com In summary, the Code requires parents/ spectators to:

- Condemn violent or illegal acts.
- Respect the referee's decisions.
- Understand that unsportsmanlike language or aggressive behaviour will not be tolerated.
- Encourage players to play by the rules and to respect opposition players and officials.
- Never ridicule a player for making a mistake.
- Participate in positive cheering that encourages all players.
- Remember that participants are involved for their own enjoyment, not yours.
- Follow the directions of the Duty Officials or Club staff.
- Never arrive at a Junior game under the influence of alcohol, never bring alcohol to a game.

A Duty Official is at every game so please raise any issues as they occur with them. If you are not satisfied that your issue has been resolved, you may submit your complaint in writing to the Dolphins (Att: Football Operations Manager, PO Box 109, Redcliffe 4020).

SOCIAL MEDIA AND MEDIA

The Dolphins acknowledges the enormous value of social networking websites to promote our Club and celebrate achievements and success. We do however expect all those postng content on social media in relation to the Club to protect and promote our brand in a positive manner.

- When posting anything that relates to the Club, you:
- Must not use offensive, provocative or hateful language.
- Must not post misleading or false information or attempt to injure the reputation of another person or our organisation.
- Must not share content that contains material, which is in breach of laws, court orders, undertakings, or contracts.
- Should respect and maintain the privacy of others.
- Must maintain the privacy of the Club's confidential information (this includes information that is not publicly accessible or widely known).
- Should promote the sport and the Club in a positive way.

When using social media, you should be considerate to others and should not post information when you have been asked not to, or where consent has not been sought and given. You must also remove information about another person if that person asks you to do so. Permission should always be sought if the use or publication of information is not incidental, but directly related to an individual. This is particularly relevant to publishing any information regarding minors. In such circumstances, parental or guardian consent is mandatory.

Branding and Intellectual Property

You must not use any of the Club, league or game's intellectual property or imagery on your personal social media without prior approval.

Intellectual property includes but is not limited to:

- Trademarks
- Logos
- Slogans and
- Imagery which has been posted on official social media sites or website.

You must not create either an official or unofficial presence using the organisation's trademarks, logos or name without prior approval. Further, the Club does not endorse the creation of private Facebook groups for teams. You must not imply that you are authorised to speak on behalf of the Club, league or game unless you have been given official authorisation to do so.

Club Photography

From time to time your child's image may be captured by photos or videos during training, games, or special events by official Club photographers. Registration with the Club serves as acknowledgement to use any images captured by the Club for the purposes of promotional material, media or other purposes without further permission being necessary. If you do NOT want your child's image to be used in any promotional material, you must advise the Club accordingly. The Club will provide you with a form to complete, confirming your request. Spectator Photography

The Club does not endorse spectators sharing photos or videos on social media of children without the express consent of the child's parent/s or guardian/s. If you are photographing or videoing your own child with other clearly identifiable children in the frame, we expect that you have obtained permission to share the image before doing so. Refrain from posting any information or photos of a sensitive nature, this could include accidents, incidents or controversial behaviour.



Coach and Manager, every team needs at least 4 other parents fill the volunteer roles of

- Touch Judge
- League Safe Officer
- Duty Official and
- Timekeeper before the team can take the field each week.

The Dolphins require that all volunteers who have direct contact with players must apply for a **Working with Children-Blue Card** (exemptions do not apply). If you have previously been disqualified from having a Blue Card it is an offence to sign a Blue Card Application Form.

There is no fee to apply for the card for volunteers.

FUNDRAISING

The Club does not endorse individual team fundraising and bears no responsibility for any funds collected by individual team members. Under no circumstances should any person make representations to businesses seeking sponsorship or donations unless expressly authorised to do so by the Club.

INSURANCE

If your child injures themselves at training or during a game, please advise the Team Manager immediately so the injury can be noted. If you have not been referred to a health specialist for further treatment by your GP, payments due to those specialists are not considered to be Insurance claimable and therefore the cost will be your responsibility.

Insurance claims must be completed within 30 days from the date of injury. Once you have your claim form completed, call our office on 3203 4754 and speak with our Staff about what you need to do before making an appointment for forms to be finalised.

Arthur J. Gallagher Insurance will send an Acknowledgement of Claim with a claim number directly to the player/parent and advise of any other requirements. Due to privacy requirements, all enquiries regarding insurance must be made directly to Arthur J. Gallagher Insurance on 3367 5006.
